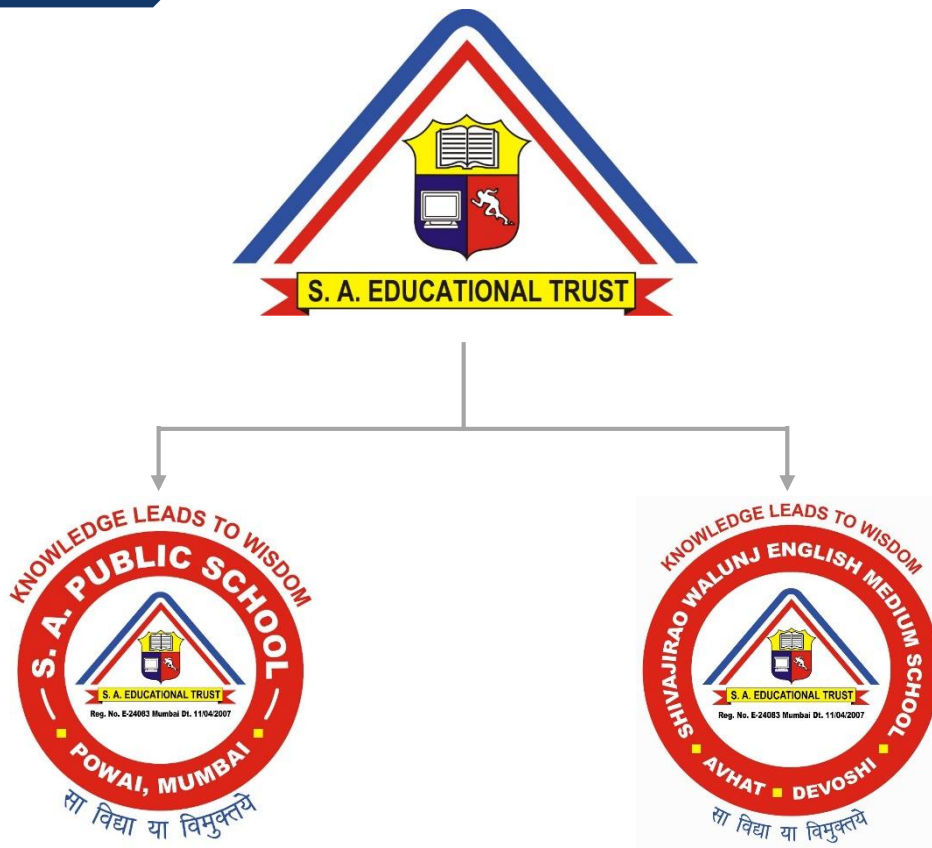

# ANNUAL REPORT 2024-25



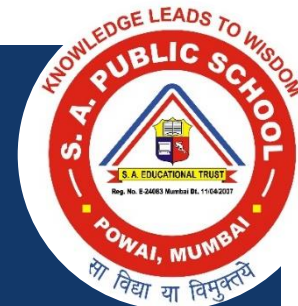

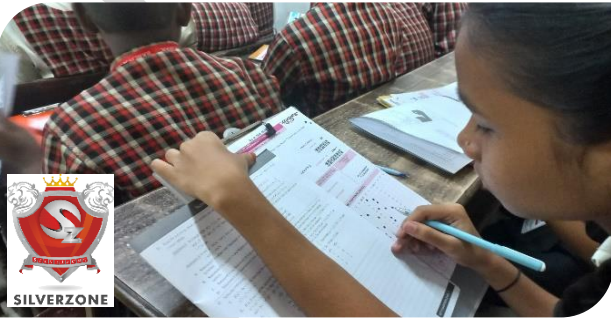
# Diwali Party
